

# Traveller's Quick Guide

Travellers to Bermuda are required to take a COVID-19 test no more than five days before arrival and complete an online Traveller Authorisation form.

All travellers are required to take a COVID-19 test upon arrival and be tested on days 4, 8 and 14 of their trip. A return home test is also arranged for visitors.

All tests are covered in the Traveller Authorisation fee, auto-scheduled for your convenience and confirmed by email.



## *Immunised travellers*

- Must have received the required dose(s) of their vaccine plus two weeks
- After arrival test, are invited to enjoy amenities at their accommodation property while awaiting lab result\*
- After negative arrival test, no restrictions on movement\*\*
- Must adhere to COVID-19 public health guidelines

\*\* Arrivals by midday typically have results in time for dinner; up to 24 hours in rare cases



## *Non-immunised travellers*

- Are required to wear a wristband
- Must quarantine in their room until their negative arrival test result is received\*\*
- Restricted activities relaxed after negative arrival test\*\*\*
- Must adhere to COVID-19 public health guidelines

\*\* Arrivals by midday typically have results in time for dinner; up to 24 hours in rare cases

\*\*\* Non-immunised travellers in the U.K. in the past 14 days must quarantine on accommodation property until day 4 negative test result, restricted activities relaxed with each negative test
